

Nonfarm Payroll Jobs

November 2015 - December 2015

Nonfarm payroll jobs in Arkansas rose 2,600 in December to total 1,227,900. Six major industry sectors added jobs, while five sectors slightly declined. The largest increase occurred in **trade**, **transportation**, **and utilities** (+2,500). Gains in retail trade (+1,300) reflected seasonal hiring for the holiday shopping season. **Manufacturing** added 1,300 jobs. A majority of the increase was in nondurable goods manufacturing (+1,000), with hiring reported in food manufacturing.

December 2014 - December 2015

Compared to December 2014, Arkansas' nonfarm payroll employment rose 19,500. Eight major industry sectors posted growth, with five adding 1,500 or more jobs, each. Three sectors decreased over the year. Employment in educational and health services increased 7,000. Gains in health care and social assistance (+7,400) more than offset minor declines in educational services (-400). Professional and business services added 6,400 jobs, with expansions across all three subsectors. Jobs in construction rose 5,300, all in specialty trade contractors (+6,400). Employment in leisure and hospitality is up 2,800, mostly in food services (+2,300). Other services increased 1,500. The industry includes activities such as laundry services and membership organizations. Employment in manufacturing decreased 4,500. Most of the losses were reported in durable goods manufacturing, down 3,800.

Hours and Earnings of Arkansas Production Workers (Manufacturing Industries)




The Year in Review

In 2015, nonfarm payroll jobs in Arkansas ranged from a low of 1,189,900 in January to a high of 1,227,900 in December. Arkansas' preliminary annual average nonfarm employment for 2015 is 1,212,100, notably higher than the 2014 average of 1,188,800.


Nonfarm Payroll Jobs (Not Seasonally Adjusted)



In 2015, the number of employed in Arkansas steadily increased, ranging from a low of 1,247,100 in January to a high of 1,273,000 in December. Dropping throughout the second half of the year, unemployment rates in Arkansas declined from a high of 5.8 percent in May to a low of 4.8 percent in December.



Technical Notes

The Arkansas Labor Market is prepared monthly in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS). The current month's estimates are preliminary, while previous data are subject to revision.

Estimates of nonfarm payroll jobs show the number of jobs by industry and reflect employment by place of work. Hours and earnings estimates are based on payroll and worker-hour data collected for production workers in manufacturing industries.

Industries are classified according to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). All estimates are based on a first quarter 2014 benchmark.

Explanation of Terms and Concepts

Monthly Business Survey of Employers

A monthly sample survey designed to provide industry information on nonfarm payroll jobs. Data are compiled each month from mail surveys and telephone interviews conducted by the Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with Department of Workforce Services. The data are based on establishment records and include all workers, full-or part-time, who received pay during the payroll period which includes the 12th of the month. Approximately 5,000 Arkansas business establishments are surveyed.

Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA)

A term applied by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget to counties that have one or more central cities and that meet specified criteria of population density, commuting patterns and social and economic integration.

Current Population Survey (CPS)

A monthly sample survey of the population 16 years of age and over, designed to provide data on the labor force, the employed and the unemployed. The survey is conducted each month by the Bureau of the Census for BLS. The information is collected by trained interviewers from a sample of about 60,000 households. The data collected are based on the activity reported for the calendar week including the 12th of the month. Approximately 800 Arkansas households are represented in the sample survey.

Civilian Labor Force

The sum of all employed and unemployed persons 16 years of age or older. Members of the Armed Forces are excluded.

An estimate of the number of persons who worked any time for pay or profit or worked 15 hours or more as unpaid workers in a family business during the calendar week which includes the 12th of the month. Also included are those who, although

ing the calendar week which includes the 12th of the month. Also included are those who, although not working, had some job attachment and were not looking for work, and persons involved in labor management disputes.

Unemployment

An estimate of the number of persons who did not have a job, but were available for work and actively seeking work during the calendar week which includes the 12th of the month.

Unemployment Rate

The number of unemployed as a percentage of the civilian labor force. Unemployment rates are calculated from unrounded data.

Seasonal Adjustment

A statistical technique applied to monthly data to eliminate changes that normally occur during the year due to seasonal events such as weather, major holidays, schedule shifts, harvest times, and the opening/closing of schools.

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The Arkansas Labor Market is produced by the Department of Workforce Services, Bureau of Labor Statistics. All Statistics are published in cooperation with the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.
